Dosage and Administration: Dosages should be restricted to the lowest level necessary to control clinical signs. If no therapeutic response is noted in seven days, the diagnosis should be redetermined.

**Recommended Dose:** 2.5 mg per 10 lb (4.5 kg) body weight per day in divided doses six to ten hours apart.

WARNING: Clinical and experimental data have demonstrated that corticosteroids administered orally or parenterally to animals may induce the first stage of parturition when administered during the last trimester of pregnancy and may precipitate premature parturition followed by dystocia, fetal death, retained placenta and metritis. Additionally, corticosteroids administered to dogs, rabbits and ordents during pregnancy have resulted in cleft palate in offspring.
